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***JOB DESCRIPTION**

The information security officer provides leadership and management of the institution's information and physical data functions for the university and its employees. These duties include responsibility for overall institutional security strategy, security architecture and systems development, and global functions oversight. The scope of this role covers all utilized security technologies and services, including protection services, perimeter defenses, physical and logical access control, and profile management of all employees, contractors and visitors. As the university's senior security officer, this person also has enterprise-level responsibility for all data/information security policies, standards, evaluations, roles and corporate awareness.

The person in this position works with user and technical groups and internal auditors in the development and implementation of a security strategy designed to provide a high level of security over data facilities and data processing while preserving and enhancing facility and system usability. The ideal candidate must be able to develop and implement flexible security solutions, dictated by the needs of a rapidly evolving decentralized academic/business environment. The individual must be a results-oriented person who can achieve tangible improvements in the corporate security arena. Excellent technical and communications skills are a must, as well as proven security leadership experience.

The information security officer will report directly to the vice president for educational technology and will have communication access to the president. He or she will have direct reports to be determined shortly after hire, which may include manager of security architecture, intellectual property/data engineer, security auditors, etc.

8-10 years of management experience at least five of which were in a security-related area in a leadership capacity, including experience with Internet technology and security issues; higher education, governmental agency or corporate/industry information security experience; excellent staff management skills; and ability to interface with top management.

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed are representative of the knowledge, skill and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Security, credit and criminal background check will be required prior to hire.

The position requires awareness and strong experience in vulnerability testing in addition to penetration testing; developing security practices as a people problem versus a technical problem; standards-based architecture with an understanding of how to get there, including compliance monitoring and enforceability; knowledge and practical application of information security "best practices," such as ISO 27001/27002, BS 17799, NIST 800-53 and ISF The Standard of Good Practice for Information Security.
